Method: The use surface of a vertically put specimen placed on a fibre cement board (loose

> laid) is ignited by a propane gas flame. Under condition of a surface flame attack with 15 s exposure time, there shall be no flame spread in excess of 150 mm vertically from the point of the test flame within 20 s from the time application.

> If the boundary line is not reached within 20 s, the sample meets the requirements

for the class E_{fl}.

3 lengthwise and 3 crosswise Number of tests: 23 ± 2 °C and 50 ± 5 % R.H. Conditioning

Fire Behaviour

Standard: EN ISO 9239-1 (2010)*

Method: A floorcovering is put on (loose laid) to a fibre cement board. During the test, the

specimen is irradiated by a gas radiator at an angle of 30°. A small flame is used to ignite the specimen. The specimen is ignited during 10 minutes. In case of inflammable specimens, the test lasts until the flame is extinguished, but 30 minutes at the most. The criterion is the burned length, from which the critical

radiant flux is deduced using a calibration curve.

Conditioning 23 ± 2 °C and 50 ± 5 % R.H.
